Updates from Principals:

**High School:**

\$3,000 choir, \$6,000 ACT Prep, \$3,000 English Townsend Press program, remediation for math, science, \$16,500 English, and social science, \$15,000 educational field trip (COVID permitting), \$5000 technology equipment. (\$48,500 total)

TSSA gives \$30,568 to support the school with resources. A student leadership team will meet 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday monthly to discuss academic goals for students and how to best use funds. Lesa Ahlstrom volunteered to represent CC on the committee.

Prom went very well for the Seniors, the Juniors won't have to be COVID tested before prom if it is outside. Lesa asked about a media broadcasting class. LaRee has been talking with Shaine from Panguitch who is working with colleges to offer a class.

**Elementary:**

Budget is the same as presented last month. (\$46,767 total) Pete received hundreds of donated masks which were shared with the high school and district. Principal P requested that some Seniors join the kindergarten for the graduation in their caps and gowns.

BVHS Counselor LaRee Bybee presented her annual report (via slides) of school data including, passing and failing grades, # of graduates, participation in extra curricular activities, test results, student leadership etc. ACT scores for this year will be available soon. Overall the school has handled COVID very well. Kathy Ann \_\_\_\_\_ is available for free, confidential student counseling during school a couple times a month (?). She is made available through the Southwest Educational Development Center.

April mentioned there is some real resistance (in the form of demonstrations) from adults and kids in other parts of the district to wearing masks.
